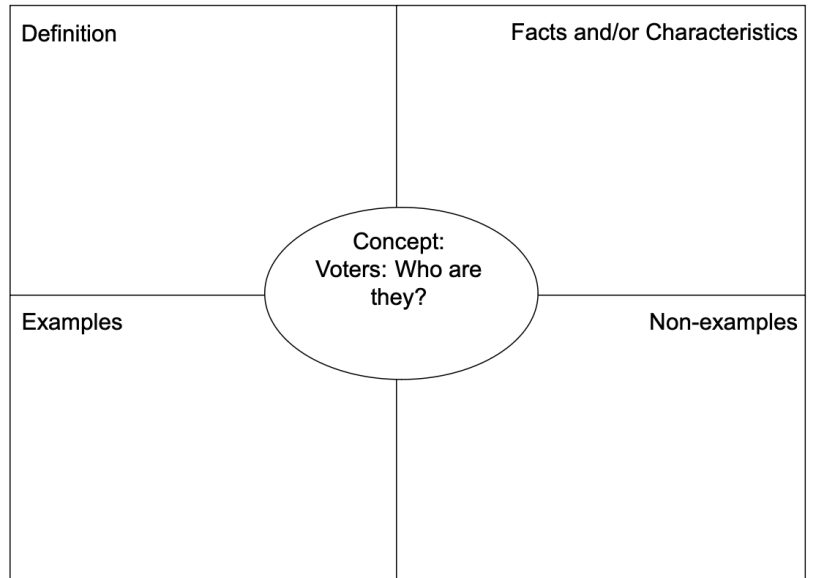
During the do-now, we've discussed how minors (people under 18) are not represented by the vote, but still have laws written to govern us. There are some other groups that also fall into that category.
